Specialists in the field Music, Art,Dance,Science,Foreign Language and Physical Fitness enrich the lives of the children

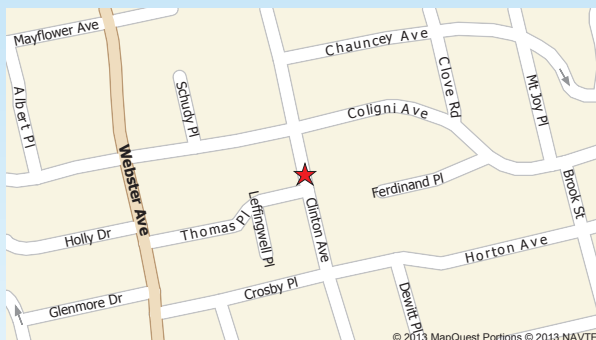

- Pre-K and Kindergarten curricula which are consistent with that used by The New Rochelle Public Schools.
- Excellent student-teacher ratios.

In a very nurturing environment, opportunities are provided for children to interact in a setting which includes family style dining. Designation of responsibilities encourages leadership skills and foster the development of self- confidence.



Parents are encouraged to attend workshops, parent meeting and special events which occur throughout the year. Workshops are designed to inform parents of current trends in parenting skills and other important related social issues. A parent representative is on the Board of Directors.

Volunteers are an integral part of the New Rochelle Day Nursery community. They provide reading hours, mentoring, office and class assistance.

The Board of Directors of the New Rochelle Day Nursery are members of the community who are elected for a specific term and who serve uncompensated. The Board of Directors oversees all the business and affairs of the Day Nursery.

A non-profit organization, licensed by the New York State Department of Social Service and accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC) was established in 1895 to meet the needs of working parents or those pursuing further education. Continuing today with the same purpose, the Nursery serves a complete cross-section of the population.

The Nursery serves children 18 months through kindergarten age. The hour of operation are from 7:30 AM to 6:00 PM, 52 weeks a year. The Nursery observes ten legal holiday.

The Nursery Includes:

A State of the Art building designed specifically for early childhood education and dedicated to this purpose.

Six spacious, well equipped, air-conditioned classroom.

A new fully equipped playground. Age appropriate equipment to provide opportunities for fun and physical activities in a safe environment

A covered porch for outdoor play which allows for the use of tricycles, wheeled toys, jump ropes and sports activities even in inclement weather.
